Dear Parent/Carer

As previously communicated last term, there will be some improvements **to our Behaviour Policy**, which will be introduced **after half term on 6th June**. The enhancements to the Policy will ensure all pupils are able to make as much progress as possible in their lessons, and support and intervention is swift and targeted.

The key updates are summarised below, however the full policy can be viewed on our website www.sthilds.org.uk.

A range of positive rewards are contained within the policy, however following poor behaviour for learning, a **'verbal warning'** will be issued. If the verbal warning is ignored a **'call back'** will be issued and the pupil will complete a **1 hour detention after school on the same day**. Parents/carers will be informed.

Further poor behaviour for learning will result in a **'call out'**, where pupils are removed from the classroom. The pupil will work in **the call out room for the remainder of the day and the next day. There will also be a 60 minute detention at the end of the first and second day**. If behaviour in 'call out' is unacceptable or if work is not completed to an acceptable standard, the pupil will be referred to the **Abbey**; you will be contacted so a meeting can be arranged prior to integration into the Abbey provision.

I would like to thank you for your continued support with the **banning of mobile phones from the school**, which has made a positive impact on the behaviour and well-being of our school community. As a reminder, **mobile phones must not be visible in school, and if seen they will be confiscated and we will then require a parent or carer to collect the phone from school**.

The last half term of the summer, which begins on **Monday 6th June 2022** is an exciting time at St. Hild's, with lots to look forward to, including Awards' Ceremonies, Alternative Curriculum Day, Year 5 and 6 Transition Days, House Competitions, and Year 11 Leaver's events which include the much awaited Prom. We expect all pupils to return safe and well rested, in full school uniform (see the website for our Uniform Policy) and ready to learn.
