Dear Parent/Carer

Your child will be participating in an assessment which will help us gather information on their aptitude for learning. The Yellis test has three sales of measurement as outlined below:

Vocabulary Score: word fluency and understanding

Maths Score: logical thinking, manipulating numbers and numerical concepts

Non-verbal Score: ability to match patterns, reflections and rotations and apply visual intuition

Pupils cannot prepare for this test and so there is no requirement for revision. We have explained to pupils that there is no need for anyone to worry that they do not finish all of the questions in any of the sections as their score is based more on the accuracy of their answers rather than the total number of questions they complete. The assessment is also adaptive allowing pupils to receive the correct level of questioning.

The test results are used to identify pupils' strengths and weaknesses, inform teaching and learning, identify gifted pupils and help identify pupils who may need additional support. The results will be shared with parents/carers via Go 4 Schools. Any issues which may arise will be addressed by school and parents/carers working together in the coming months. We will also make use of the results along with Key Stage 2 SATs results to review the setting in some subjects. You will have an opportunity to discuss this further if you wish on **Target Setting Evening, Monday 30th September 2019 at 4.00pm**, where we will deliver a presentation detailing what the results of the test mean for your child and how we set targets at St. Hild's. You can also collect a print out of the full information for your child if you wish.
