Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that we will be changing the way we set targets for your child and report progress to parents/carers over the coming academic year. This is in response to changes to National external assessments and the way we share assessment information with you and your child. The changes will help you, and more importantly your child, keep track of their progress as they move through our School.

We will continue to produce one written report for each year group but have added in an additional data capture point, as detailed in the table below:

Data Capture 1	w/c 11.11.2019
Data Capture 2 plus	w/c 27.01.2020
Full Report	w/c 03.02.2020
Data Capture 3	w/c 20.04.2020

The target for your child in each subject area will be determined by national data along with their prior attainment at Key Stage 2, MidYIS (taken in Year 7) and Yellis (taken in Year 10) data, as well as their current progress. Progress against these targets will be carefully monitored by teachers, Subject Leaders and the Senior Team to ensure your child receives the correct level of support and challenge.

The new targets will appear in Go4Schools over the next few weeks and a Parent/Carer Briefing Session with me has been scheduled for **Monday 30th September 2019 from 4:30pm to 5:00pm** in the School Chapel. The session will cover the new reporting cycle, how we set your child's targets and how parents/carers can make good use of Go4Schools to monitor progress. This will also be an opportunity for parents/carers to ask any questions about how we manage their child's learning at St. Hild's.
