St. Hild's Church of England School: COVID-19 guidance for pupils & visitors

At St. Hild's Church of England School we care about the health and safety of our pupils, staff and community. This letter is to inform you of our response to the current development of the coronavirus.

The current advice from the Government states that schools should stay open, however this advice may change at short notice as the spread of COVID-19 continues. If we are required to fully or partially close, we will take the necessary steps to ensure that you are informed and that the effect on pupils' education is limited, particularly for our Year 11 pupils. We are putting in place plans to ensure all pupils have work and will inform you of this as due course. Please check our website regularly for updates.

The Government's advice is that anyone developing symptoms consistent with COVID-19, however mild, should **self-isolate for 14 days**. The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature

If your child is displaying these symptoms, or there is someone else at home with these symptoms, then your child must not come in to school and you should contact the school immediately. Your child should remain at home until the period of self-isolation has been completed, as given by the guidance below which is regularly updated.
