Coronavirus (COVID-19) is currently headline news and quite rightly is causing a great deal of concern. I am writing to inform you of the processes and procedures St. Hild's has put in place in order to address the daily advice from Public Health England.

In the event of any closure, we will send you a message via SchoolCal, Twitter and the website www.sthilds.org.uk

Until we are informed otherwise we remain open and expect all pupils to attend as usual unless they have been instructed to self-isolate. If you do suspect you have any symptoms then you must contact NHS111.

We are ensuring that the cleaning of our school is more robust, especially in the key touch areas and have made provision for hand sanitiser to be available. Our hand washing areas remain well-stocked and pupils know how to properly wash their hands; hand washing posters are in every classroom and all toilets.

We are closely monitoring trips and will make decisions following the latest advice from the government.

Work for pupils is being prepared should we have to close the school for any length of time. It is important that you encourage your child to complete this work so that they do not miss out on their learning. Your child should also be encouraged to read and practise their maths skills; MathsWatch will support them.

If your child is in Year 11, packs of work will be available both electronically and in hard copy format so they can continue to fully prepare for their final examinations. Contingency plans are in place for controlled assessments and any interruption will not disadvantage the pupils.

I am aware that this is a very worrying and uncertain time, but I can reassure you that we have your child's best interests as our top priority in terms of health and education and will closely follow advice from the experts.
